Kath will have templates and small scraps of different backing fabrics available to share and experiment with. Flannel is the ideal fabric to use, and she will bring a selection of pre-cut strips to get us all started but extra flannel will be available at a small charge for those who would like it. The emphasis will be on experimentation and having fun!
