

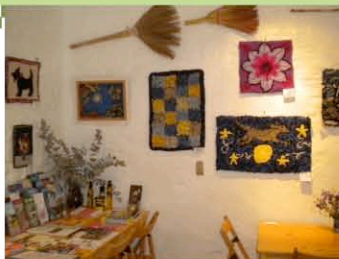

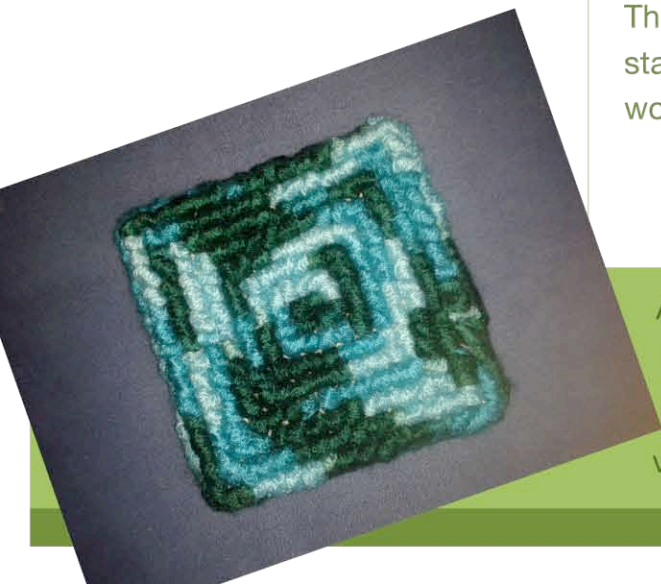
Stillingfleet Picnic & Exhibition
